

## Short description of the project and scope of eHospital

The eHospital project includes the realisation of a blended-learning system (integration of Internet-based eLearning modules into conventional lessons and into self-learning phases which are accompanied by a mentor or teletutor and which shall initialise the organisation of Internet-based club and course systems) within the scope of the promotion programme “MIA – Mitteldeutsche Industrieregion im Aufbruch (lernende Region Halle)” (“Middle German industrial region setting off (learning region Halle)”) of the BMBF (Federal ministry for Education and Research).

Within the scope of pilot projects, this system is currently being offered at the Bad Kösen childrens rehab hospital for pupils who are disadvantaged due to long-term rehab or hospital stays and as project journeys which are offered nation-wide (sensible fusion of class outing and project week with top themes like networking technologies and virtual reality self-learning modules) in cooperation with the German Youth Hostel Association (Deutscher Jugendherbergsverband).

The targets of these learning systems are

1. Familiarising learners with learning technologies which are required for Lifelong Learning and
2. Conveying information about topics which are relevant to economy and society and which offer good professional options (e.g. IT area of networking technologies and 3D-programming).

Modules with further contents ranging down to the preschool area are being developed. The frame structures for a wide-ranging implementation are being designed within the scope of the initiative Porta Quadra. This structure is presented along with an exemplary programme.

1. Project area of the Landesschule Pforta (alma mater by Friedrich Nietzsche)
2. Institut Porta Didactica e.V. – scientific research on new didactics and methodics
3. Porta Paedagogica learning technology center – Implementation with respect to the learners
4. Porta Paedagogica learning academy – Implementation with respect to the teachers

A communication center with special focus on Internet-based learning processes is under development.
